This is the fourth installment of an ongoing bi-monthly series of themed trivia nights that the Ferndale Library has been hosting in partnership with 215 West (the event space located next door to SOHO on 9 Mile in downtown Ferndale). The next trivia night theme will be "Camp Classics & B-Movies."

What is "Camp" when it comes to films? Well, according to writer Paul Madley in V Magazine, camp is "an aesthetic style and sensibility that admires bad taste and ironic value...it's theatrical, effeminate, witty...it borders on satire, but it's about being in on the joke...it's a postmodern viewpoint." And what are b-movies, per se? Predominantly any movie that was very obviously made with a considerably low budget, and that's often led to the presumption that b-movies are either bad, cheesy, or of low quality..., but that's not always the case! (Attendees are free to bring in their own food in containers).
